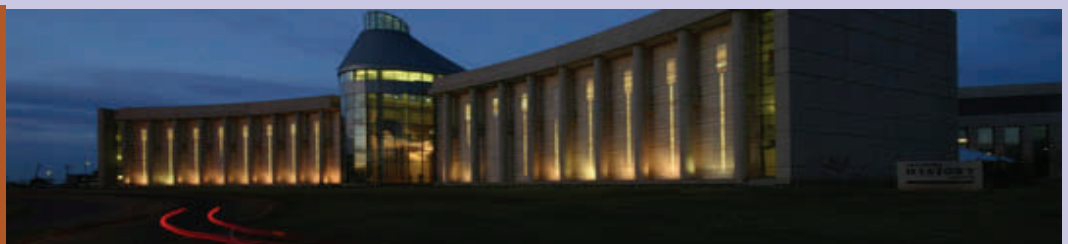
OKAMA Spring 2011 Conference – Tuesday March 29, 2011

The Oklahoma Ambulance Association will be holding its Spring Conference on Tuesday March 29th at the Oklahoma History Center in Oklahoma City.

This year's speakers will include Gail Atnip from TrailBlazers, Maria Bianchi the Executive Director from the American Ambulance Association and Alicia Barton from Accufile.

*The host site for the OKAMA conference is the Oklahoma History Center, Chesapeake Room. The center houses the history museum of the State of Oklahoma, and is located across the street from the Governor's mansion at **2401 N. Laird Avenue in Oklahoma City**. The museum opened in 2005 and is operated by the Oklahoma Historical Society. The museum preserves the history of Oklahoma from prehistoric Native American tribes to the present day.*

From Tulsa

Take I-44 West to I-35. Head South on I-35. Exit on NE 23rd Street. Proceed West past N. Kelley 1/4 mile. The entrance is on the North (right) of NE 23rd Street.

From Norman

Take I-35 North to the I-40 & I-35 junction. Continue North on I-235 to NE 23rd exit. Head East (right) on NE 23rd Street. Pass Lincoln Blvd, the entrance is North (left) on NE 23rd Street.

From Guthrie

Take I-35 South. Exit on NE 23rd Street. Proceed West past N. Kelley 1/4 mile. The entrance is North (right) of NE 23rd Street.

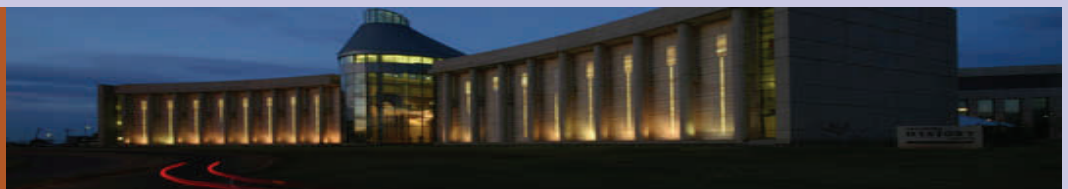
From El Reno

Take I-40 West to I-35. Head North on I-235 to NE 23rd Street exit. Head East (right) on NE 23rd Street. Pass Lincoln Blvd, the entrance is North (left) of NE 23rd Street.

From Shawnee

Take I-40 West to I-35. Head North on I-235 to NE 23rd Street exit. Proceed West past N. Kelley 1/4 mile. The entrance is North (right) of NE 23rd Street.

Alicia Barton, Medical Billing Consultant and Medicaid Specialist for Accufile

Medicaid Billing 101

In this instructional seminar on Medicaid, participants will learn from one of the experts in this industry the “how to” of billing and collections of Medicaid patients. In this “Medicaid 101” session, participants will learn how to “speak the language” of Medicaid and the five most important aspects in filing a Medicaid claim. OKAMA members who are having difficulty with Medicaid claims will not want to miss this important session.

Alicia has 23 years in the medical field such as labor & delivery, geriatrics, family practice, and orthopedics. She has spent the last 8 years working for HP, the fiscal agent to the Oklahoma HealthCare Authority. She first joined HP as the Team Lead for their Call Center and eventually accepted the position of Provider Field Consultant serving the NW portion of the Oklahoma. While working for HP, Alicia became very knowledgeable of the OHCA’s policies, procedures and billing requirements.

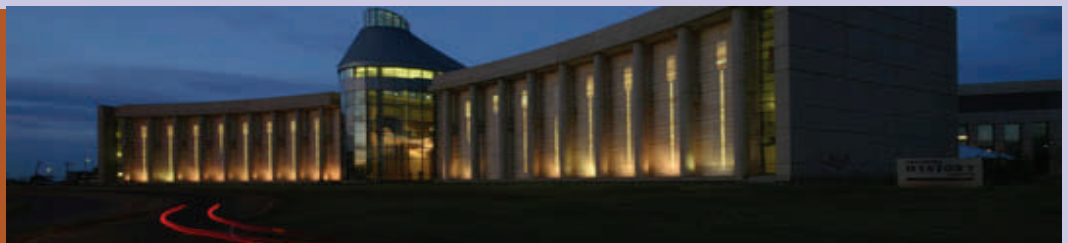

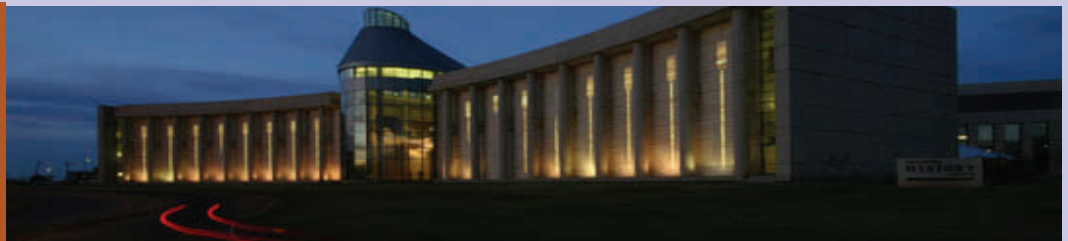
